Beginning September 28, 15 mural artists from across the country will be in Pecos throughout the week creating large-scale works of public art. Inspired by Pecos' history, culture, landscapes and people, the artists will transform walls throughout the community into vibrant murals that residents and visitors can enjoy for years to come.
